Energy our Bodies Use

Interviewer: Dr Baker, can you tell us about the energy our bodies use?

20 to 30 percent of the total energy output of the body .

Interviewer: Right. Where does our energy come from?

Dr Baker: Mainly from calories, which we get from different types of food.

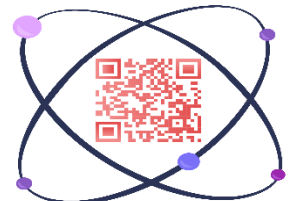

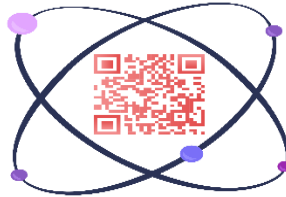

Pilot Accidentally Triggers Hijacking Alarm
